Golf Québec/Fondation Aléo



AMOUNT

2,000 per bursary.

OBJECTIVE

To help golfers financially while encouraging them to pursue and succeed in their studies in parallel with their sporting career.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

1. Member of Golf Québec.
2. Main residence in Québec.
3. Be a full-time or part-time student at an educational institution, including a virtual institution.
 - a. Accepted institutions:
 - i. Canadian institutions (elementary and secondary schools, CEGEPs, colleges, and universities).
 - ii. American high schools recognized as "Prep Schools".
 - b. Institutions that are not accepted:
 - i. American institutions (Colleges, Junior Colleges, NCJAA, universities, and NCAA).
4. Committed to developing their sporting talent and striving for the highest level of performance.
5. Represent Golf Québec in national and international competitions.
6. Aged between 13 and 18 years of age on August 1, 2026.

PERFORMANCE CRITERIA

Selection made according to the following criteria and in the order presented:

1. Athletes identified at Excellence level*.
2. Athletes identified at Élite level*.
3. Athletes identified at Relève level*.
4. Top two (2) finishers on the Bantam Provincial Order of Merit (2 boys and 2 girls).
5. Based on their ranking on the Golf Québec Boys' and Girls' Overall Order of Merit.

*See athlete identification criteria.

NOTES

- Based on previous season's results as of October 31.
- No form to be completed by the athlete to submit his or her candidacy.
- Golf Québec will provide the Foundation with the names of candidates/athletes eligible to receive bursaries.
- A 12-year-old athlete may be exceptionally eligible if he or she is identified in the federated Relève, Élite or Excellence rankings.
- An athlete may not receive a bursary if he or she has been or is part of a provincial team from another province.
- Athletes may not receive a Golf Québec/Fondation Aléo bursary if they are already receiving another bursary:
 - Pat Rhéaume Fund.
 - Programme Équipe Relève Aléo.
 - Fondation Aléo: provincial scholarship program.
