Golf Québec's Junior Skills Tour

The Junior Skills Tour is a program offered to youngsters aged 6 to 14 (members and non-members of Golf Québec) that focuses on the key skills of golf: driving, chipping and putting.

The program includes five (5) official qualifiers across the province and a grand finale to be held in conjunction with the Fenergic Canada Cup in Victoriaville on August 10, 2026. During the qualifying rounds, the winners in each category will receive an entry pass to the provincial finals.

Selection Process

Provincial Junior Championship

Girls

Each bantam player participating in a RJT event among those identified by their respective region will be required to play a score of 90 or less. If the player plays 90 or less, she will be given a differential. When all identified RJT events are completed, a minimum of 8 spots will be kept for all bantam players. If the maximum score is not respected for one or more of those spots reserved for bantam players, the spot(s) will be given back to Golf Québec, who will be able to give it to the next best player on the differential list of junior/juvenile players.

Pee-wee players are not allowed to participate in the Girls' Provincial Junior Championship.

Golf Québec retains 5 discretionary places and reserves the right to allocate additional places if needed

Boys

Each bantam player participating in a RJT event among those identified by their respective region will be required to play a score of 85 or less. If the player plays 85 or less, he will be given a differential. When all identified RJT events are completed, the 14 best bantam players will be invited to participate. If the maximum score is not respected for one or more of the 14 spots allocated to bantam players, the spot(s) will be given back to Golf Québec, who will be able to give it to the next best player on the differential list of junior/juvenile players.

Pee-wee players are not allowed to participate in the Boys' Provincial Junior Championship.

** Golf Québec retains 10 discretionary places and reserves the right to allocate additional places if needed.*



Qualifying Rounds

Provincial Junior Championship

Again, this year, each regional association will be required **to identify one event of the RJT** to qualify for the Boys' and Girls' Junior Provincial Championship and submit this information to Golf Québec. Golfers must qualify through the designated tournament in their respective regions.

From March 2, 2026, all players will have to register themselves for the event, whether they are exempt or not.

Canadian Junior Girls Championship: The three (3) players who will represent Golf Québec at the Canadian Junior Girls Championship will be the top three competitors on the Junior Girls Quota Order of Merit as of July 9, 2026.*

Ties: In the event of a tie for a place on the team or for the selection of participants, the players will be determined by sudden-death playoff once the final round of the provincial championship has been completed.

Canadian Junior Boys Championship

QUOTA for the Canadian Junior Boys Championship: 14

(Golf Québec could have more than 14 players depending on the spots given at the NextGen Championships)

1. **Canadian Junior Boys Championship Quota Order of Merit** is used to select the 3 players composing the team representing Golf Québec.
2. The next 8 players in the **Canadian Junior Boys Championship Quota Order of Merit.**
3. 2 spots will be given according to the results at the Provincial Junior Championship.
4. Golf Québec reserves 1 discretionary exemption.

Ties: In the event of a tie for a place on the team or for the selection of participants, the players will be determined by sudden-death playoff once the final round of the provincial championship has been completed.

If players who are already exempted are also among the top 11 on the boys' junior OOM quota, their places will be given to the next players on the OOM list.

Selection Method (boys and girls)

The Assante Optimist Classic will serve as the official qualifier for the Bantam, Pee wee, and Mosquito championships. 26 exemptions will be granted for boys and 7 for girls.

If an athlete is unable to qualify at the Optimist Classic, they will have a chance to be exempted by their regional association. Each regional association will have a set number of exemptions. It will be responsible for and independent in its management of these exemptions.



U15 Canadian Championship

Date : August 25 to 27, 2026

Selection process:

Open to all boys and girls aged 15 and younger as of August 1st, 2026. Selection is made by Golf Canada

Exemption :

Both Boys' and Girls' bantam champions will be exempted for the U15 Canadian Championship.

Other players who wish to participate must submit their application to Golf Canada.

Selection process - invitational only

Each region will have to determine its own regional selection process.

Regional teams should be composed of 2 juvenile boys, 2 bantam boys, 2 pee-wee boys, and 2 girls (juvenile, bantam or pee-wee).

Scoring System

A skills contest will take place in the morning, including longest drive and putting.

- 1 player from each region per category for the longest drive challenge;
- 1 player from each region per category for the putting challenge.

In the afternoon, an 18-hole shotgun round is scheduled (2 players scramble, Stableford).



Orders of Merit



Points Distribution Charts

Points distribution charts are used according to the number of players entered in each competition. You can consult these charts in the [rankings](#) section of our website.

The same number of points is awarded to players who are tied for a specific rank.

The committee may add or delete tournaments during the season.

For bantams, only an athlete's eight (8) best results will be retained for the OOM for the period from April 1, 2026, to October 15, 2026.

The OOM will be finalized on October 20, 2026. **No corrections** will be made after this date.

For all stroke-play tournaments : When there is a cut, all cut players will receive the equivalent of 5% of the winner's points.

Inter-regional Championship: The point distribution chart for 10 players or fewer will be used for this tournament. If all 9 regions are represented, the points for 8th place will be awarded to 8th and 9th place.
