Where to start?

An active profile in the [Golf Canada Score Centre](#) is required to register for regional and/or provincial competitions. The profile must contain a **date of birth** and an **e-mail address** that is not used by any other profile (active or not). This same e-mail address must also be used as a **username** for the active profile.

If you are a new member at a Golf Québec member club

Contact your club's administration to activate your profile.

If you've moved from one Golf Québec member club to another

Ask your new club to retrieve your existing profile. Creating a second profile will cause identification problems when registering for tournaments.

Provincial Differential Chart

The Provincial Differential Chart is a ranking system used to select players for the Triple Crown competitions (Alexander of Tunis, Duke of Kent, and Men's Provincial Amateur Championship).

Differential

Calculation between a player's gross score and the evaluation of the course played.
(Ex.: A score of 80, played on a course rated at 69.3, gives a differential of 10.7).

Provincial Differential

All designated rounds* played by a golfer between **April 1, 2025, and June 17, 2026**, are accumulated and a differential is assigned to each of them. **On June 18, the golfer's two best differentials** are added together; this new value, called the **Provincial Differential**, is then used to create this chart.

It is the golfer's responsibility to verify that the assigned differential is correct and to inform Golf Québec, **before June 18, 2026**, if any additions or corrections must be made. If this is the case, the golfer must contact **Diane Bruneau**, Competition Coordinator: dbruneau@golfQuébec.org.

The **Men's Triple Crown Order of Merit** will be used to select the golfers who will make up the Golf Québec team and qualify for the national championship.

These competitions also award points for the **Men's Amateur Order of Merit**. The same points distribution chart will be used for both orders of merit.
