



Provincial differential chart and list of designated rounds

The Provincial Differential Chart is a ranking used to select players for the Triple Crown series competitions (Alexandre de Tunis, Duc de Kent and the Men's Provincial Amateur Championship).

Differential :

Calculation between a player's gross score and the evaluation of the course played. (Ex.: A score of 80 played on a course rated at 69.3, gives a differential of 10.7).

Provincial differential, 2026 season:

All designated rounds played by a golfer between April 1, 2025, and June 17, 2026 will be accumulated and a differential is awarded for each. On June 17, 2026, the golfer's two (2) best differentials are added together; this new value, called the Provincial Differential, is then used to create the table.

If you've never competed at provincial level, it's possible to build a provincial differential through the rounds designated in the table below.

It is the golfer's responsibility to verify that the differential assigned is correct and to inform Golf Québec, before June 17, 2026, if an addition or correction needs to be made.
